The history of tonic water begins in 17th, century Peru when Spanish colonists discovered a treatment for malaria in the bark of the quinaquina tree. One account insists that the Countess of Chinchon, the Peruvian viceroy's wife, took the bark to Spain around 1640 after it saved her from malaria. Another proposes that a Jesuit missionary named Barnabe de Cobo made the first trans-Atlantic delivery in 1632. Whichever the case may be, the ground bark became known as both "Countess's powder" and "Jesuit's powder" throughout Europe. In the 18th century Carolus Linnaeus chose to classify the quinaquina tree as genus "cinchona (sīngkō`nə) or chinchona (chīngkō`nə), name for species of the genus *Cinchona*, " in honor of the legendary lady. Cinchona bark is extremely bitter, so someone mixed it with sugar and carbonated water to make it more palatable. In 1858, it was first marketed commercially. Around the same time, gin was shedding its less-than-positive reputation to become a more respectable drink. Thus, a classic was born.

East Imperial Burma Tonic

Warm and spicy with a hint of cinnamon, top notes of lemongrass and lime.

East Imperial Yuzu Tonic

Robust and aromatic sweet citrus flavour, strong Japanese citrus fruit.

East Imperial Grapefruit Tonic

Delightful bouquet of fresh pink grapefruit flesh, packed with pomelo and citrus zest.

East Imperial Soda Water

Heavy hints of minerality, zero quinine.

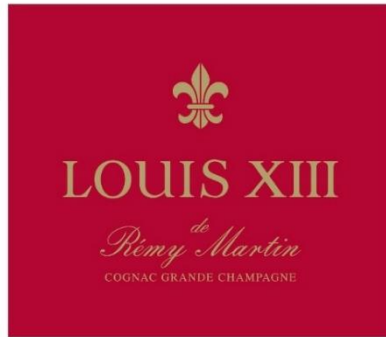
