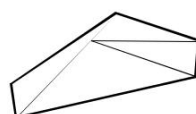

#### Domaine Armand Rousseau

Domaine Armand Rousseau is one of the most famous and best domaines in Burgundy. Based in Gevrey-Chambertin, the estate is formed of just over 15 hectares, over half of which is Grand Cru. This is one of Burgundy's greatest domaines – in terms of history, vineyard holdings and quality of wine. The original Armand Rousseau was at the forefront of the first wave of domaine bottling in the 1930s.

Today Eric, grandson of Armand, is in charge of the vines and cellar, with the help of his daughter Cyrielle. While the wines are by far some of the most collectible, commanding high prices on the secondary market, the family makes great wines with the hope that they will be drunk, not traded – a hope that we share.

*A SPECIAL NOTE FROM THE MAKER:* The wines below are on a very special price offer. We would like to encourage A.R fans to consume the wines at the restaurant, even though the wines are still young we believe that our wines should be made more accessible to everyone.

#### Domaine Henri Bonneau

Henri Bonneau remains a legend to most Chateauneuf du Pape fans and collectors. The first vintage produced by Henri Bonneau was in 1956 and he continued to make wine in his 70's.

Sadly, in March, 2016, Henri Bonneau passed away at 78 years of age. Following his passing, the son of Henri Bonneau, Marcel Bonneau was placed in charge of the estate. Marcel Bonneau took full control of the winemaking starting with the 2016 vintage.

Rustic does not begin to describe the caves, walls or barrels of this domaine. The best description of this incredible cave would be a web of decrepit, catacombs. Lighting was kept to a minimum with a few dangling light bulbs on wires, carelessly strung across the low rocky, ceiling.

This was the world of Henri Bonneau where some of the best, most sought after Chateauneuf du Pape wines were made.

Most of Henri Bonneau wines are famously made with 90% of grenache and balance of either 10% Mourvedre, Syrah, Counoise, Vaccarese. And pairs beautifully with all types of classic meat dishes, beef, lamb, duck, veal and game as well as hearty asian

dishes.

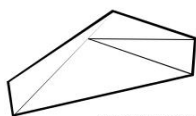
